



STONE PEOPLES LODGE

This Lodge is done in a Chipewa tradition. The Lodge follows the four round tradition, with each round honoring and focused on a certain direction East, South, West and North. During each round after the door is closed the water pourer leads the lodge in song and prayer. Participants will be given the opportunity to leave the Lodge between each round with the option to return before the door closes.

Things participants need to bring to attend the Lodge:

- ✧ T-shirt and shorts or a bathing suit to wear in the Lodge
- ✧ Towel to sit on
- ✧ One gallon of water
- ✧ Blanket for warmth outside the Lodge, just during the winter months
- ✧ A giveaway for the Water Pourer and the Fire Keeper - tobacco, sweet grass, or things that say take me.

Times for this Lodge: The first Saturday and the 3rd Tuesday of each month, we try to enter the Lodge by 6:00 PM and request that participants are there by 5:00 PM. Later if need be.
