Directions to Missouri Army National Guard Armory at Jefferson Barracks

- **From Intersection of Interstate 70 and 270:**

Drive South on Interstate 270. Exit onto Telegraph Road (Exit 2).

- **From Downtown St. Louis:**

Drive South on Interstate 55. Take Exit 197, I-255 Chicago. Exit onto Telegraph Road (Exit 2).

- **From South of St. Louis:**

Take Interstate 55 North. Take Exit 196, I-255 Chicago East. Exit onto Telegraph Road (Exit 2). This exit will lead to a stop light.

From all directions:

- Make left turn onto Telegraph Road. You will go over the highway to a stop light. Continue through the stop light. The next stop light will be at Sheridan Road. Make a right turn. There will be a sign on your right saying Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery. Continue past the cemetery until the road comes to an end, make left turn. The road will curl around for a short distance and dead ends at Sherman Road. Make a right turn. Straight ahead will be the Jefferson Barracks Post. Turn left and follow the fence line around the open field to the main entrance where you will see a Jet on the field.
- After the Guard clears you for entrance, keep straight ahead and after you pass the stop sign for a short distance, make a right turn at the first or second corner. Drive until you arrive at a large parking lot. There you will see your destination, the newest building on the post, Building 24.


